RECOMMENDATIONS FOR JUNIOR COUNSELORS

- 1) Junior Counselors should be with their co-Counselor when the campers arrive to welcome them.
- 2) Junior Counselors must receive permission from the Director to leave camp property during any given camp. They should also notify their co-Counselor if they have to leave.
- 3) Junior Counselors should be present with their co-Counselor and campers during cabin devotions and chapel times.
- 4) Junior Counselors should always try to maintain positive working relations between themselves and their co-Counselors. Never cause division between the Counselor and the campers. Do not usurp authority over the Counselor. If there is a problem between yourself and the co-Counselor, discuss it with him/her. If need be, go to the Director for further discussion to resolve the situation.
- 5) Junior Counselors should be in the cabins before the time for "lights out" commences.
- 6) The Junior Counselor is to adhere to all the guidelines established for other camp staff. There are no exemptions unless authorized by the Director.
- 7) The Junior Counselor should be prepared to assist in many various ways which will facilitate the success of the camp program.
