

INTRODUCTION

- 1) Read Deuteronomy 6:4-8 and Matthew 18:1-4. Impress on them as children.
- 2) Children can be taught the Word of God. Don't leave it until adulthood.
- 3) Children can believe the Word of God. They can trust in it and not be disappointed.
- 4) Children are not small adults. Ask them to learn the Word of God as children. Keep it simple. Don't ask them to imitate adults. In God's eyes we should act like "big" children. Children are the pattern for the citizens of heaven.

EVANGELISM WITH CHILDREN

- 1) Children are lost. They are not necessarily Christians. Salvation through infant baptism is irrelevant. The age of accountability comes at the first hint of moral consciousness.
- 2) We know we are sinners, because we do wrong things and know it.
 - a) How do we show kids this? The Bible shows them. For example, Romans 3:23.
- 3) Understanding of the reason Jesus Christ died on the cross.
 - a) 1 Corinthians 15:1-4. Becoming a Christian is a personal, individual thing.
- 4) Commitment
 - a) John 3:16. Believing that their sin was taken care of when Jesus died on the cross.
 - b) They understand this concretely and not subjectively.
 - c) Faith is a response to the truths that can be understood.
 - d) They don't need to know all the ins-and-outs of theology.
 - e) Give them the depths they need.

EVANGELISM FOR CHILDREN

- 1) We can't assume they know about Christ and their sin. We need to teach them.
- 2) Lead with groundwork. Start by getting them interesting in the Bible and what it says.
- 3) The Bible is the avenue by which people are saved. Being saved is a birth by the Spirit of God. The Spirit of God using the seed of the word of God to change our lives. Ephesians 1:13 (a. Word of God, b. Spirit of God).
- 4) Introduce them to Jesus. Mark 10:13-14. Listen to God as he is speaking to the child.
- 5) Understand children. Children want our approval. They want us to approve of their decision for Christ. Determine the difference between true salvation and a false profession. They may give a false profession to make you stop seeking them out.



THE "DO'S AND DON'TS" OF HOW TO LEAD A CHILD TO CHRIST

- 1) <u>Do</u> be approachable. Do appropriate things to make yourself available to talk.
- 2) <u>Do</u> be observant. They lead with cues that they are interested in talking.
- 3) <u>Don't</u> button-hole children. Don't make them feel bad if they aren't saved.
- 4) <u>Do</u> be prepared. Have an easy way to explain salvation to them.
 - a) John 3:16 God's Part; Your Part.
 - b) What do they want?
 - c) Why do they want it?
 - d) How do they get what they want?
- 5) <u>Don't</u> deal with more than one camper at a time. No one is saved by saying "ME TOO!"
- 6) <u>Do</u> be definite. We have authority to teach what the Bible says.
 - a) <u>Don't</u> assume anything.
 - b) Consider NEED, WAY, COST.
 - c) Decide based on that.
- 7) <u>Don't</u> be over anxious. This decision is eternal don't try to hurry it on.
- 8) <u>Don't</u> put words into their mouths.
 - a) No "follow this prayer" stuff.
 - b) If they aren't ready leave it.
 - c) The "Hound of Heaven" will not leave them alone.
- 9) <u>Do</u> be confident.
 - a) John 5:24. Using Scripture as your authority, remind them that the Bible says they are a Christian.
 - b) Tell a friend who will encourage them.
 - c) Don't tell them to tell their parents right away. That may cause immediate friction and may prevent them from remaining interested.
- 10) <u>Do</u> follow-up work. Keep in touch with them over the year.


QUICK LIST OF VERSES

Sometime a simple answer will be sufficient; other times more detail will be required. Here is a list of questions that may be asked of you. Take a few minutes and think about how you would answer. Remember, the Camp Director, Speaker and other Counselors are available to help you give an answer – you are not alone.

Questions about God:

- 1) How do we know God exists?
- 2) What if God never speaks to me? How do I know he is near if I can't see Him or feel Him near me?
- 3) How does God speak to people? How can we know God's will? What if it is something I don't want to do?

Questions about the bible;

- 1) How do we know the bible is right?
- 2) Who wrote the Bible? How do we know? How do we know they wrote what God wanted? How did they know what to write?
- 3) Why is my bible different to the Catholic, Jehovah's Witness, Mormon editions?
- 4) Where should I start reading the Bible?
- 5) What if I don't understand the bible? Or parts of it?
- 6) What are good verses to learn?

Questions about sin and salvation:

- 1) What does it mean to be saved?
- 2) How can I be sure that I'm saved?
- 3) If my parents go to church, are they saved? Am I saved if I go to church?
- 4) Am I saved if I'm baptized as a baby?

General Questions

- 1) Why are innocent people allowed to suffer?
- 2) Why did God let something happen to me?
- 3) Do you have to be good to be saved?
- 4) What does baptism mean?
- 5) I always pray. But what am I doing wrong, because God doesn't seem to answer them?
- 6) Why is my Bible different to the Catholic, Jehovah's Witness, Mormon editions
- 7) Why pray in Jesus name? Why do we attach His name to prayers?
- 8) What does "Amen" mean?
- 9) Why do we pray to God the Father? And not Jesus?
